<b>Concrete Litter Container</b>	<b>Description</b>
	<p><b>Background</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Predominantly used prior to 2005 in the former City of Hamilton</li> </ul> <p><b>Operational Considerations</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Open top allows accumulation of rain and snow</li> <li>Larger sized opening allows larger sized bags of waste to be deposited into the container</li> </ul> <p><b>Estimated Replacement Cost</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>\$900 to &gt;\$1,000</li> </ul>
<b>Fluted Metal Litter Container</b>	<b>Description</b>
	<p><b>Background</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Most common style of litter container being used by the City since 2005</li> <li></li> </ul> <p><b>Operational Considerations</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Container includes a fixed lid and a side-opening door</li> <li>Open top causes accumulation of rain and snow</li> <li>Smaller sized opening encourages litter use only</li> <li>Maintenance concerns include corrosion and metal components seizing during cold weather</li> </ul> <p><b>Estimated Replacement Cost</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>&gt;\$1,000</li> </ul>
<b>Public Space Recycling Container</b>	<b>Description</b>
	<p><b>Background</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Multi-sort container introduced to encourage recycling in public spaces</li> <li>Approximately 45 containers located in Downtown Hamilton</li> </ul> <p><b>Operational Considerations</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Container includes separate compartments to collect litter, beverage containers, and papers</li> <li>Openings are located on the front and back of the container</li> <li>Smaller sized opening encourages litter collection only</li> <li>Container includes information panels for program promotion</li> </ul> <p><b>Estimated Replacement Cost</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>&gt;\$1,700</li> </ul>

Glasdon Jubilee™ Litter Container	Description
 	<p><b>Background</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• New style of litter container introduced in 2015</li> <li>• Approximately 200 containers located in BIAs across the City</li> </ul> <p><b>Operational Considerations</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Openings are located on all sides of the container</li> <li>• Smaller sized opening discourages large items from being placed inside the container</li> <li>• Container includes information panels for program promotion</li> <li>• Container is modular, allowing it to be converted into a public space recycling container if two units are installed side-by-side</li> <li>• An optional ashtray can be installed on the top of the container</li> </ul> <p><b>Estimated Cost</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• \$600 to \$800, per unit excluding optional ashtray</li> </ul>
