Mr. Michael Cvitkovic addressed the Committee respecting the 2017 North American Indigenous Games with the aid of a PowerPoint presentation. Mr. Cvitkovic's presentation included, but was not limited to, the following:

- The North American Indigenous Games (NAIG) will be held in Hamilton, July 16-23, 2017
- This week-long sporting and cultural event will provide Indigenous youth with the opportunity to showcase their athletic achievements and cultural heritage from across Turtle Island
- 5,250 Participants from 13 provinces and territories in Canada and 13 regions in the United States
- 2 Cultural Festivals and 14 sports
- Responding to Truth and Reconciliation Commission Call to Action #88
- A budget of \$10.4M which is funded mainly from both the Federal Government (\$3.5M) and the Provincial Government (\$3.5M)
- Mr. Cvitkovic requested, from the City of Hamilton, a cash investment of \$100K to 2017 NAIG with all funds directed within the City of Hamilton and the Western Hub Cultural Village staged at McMaster University; and, an investment of \$150K in-kind to 2017 NAIG with all assets and services re-invested within the City of Hamilton to promote NAIG and City involvement
