2. The City of Burlington has two permit fees for a residential house. For a house with a total area of up to 300 square metres the fee is \$12.42 per square metre, for a house over 300 square metres the fee is \$16.00 per square metre. In the table the lower fee was used for comparison purposes, if the higher fee had been used then the average for a residential house would have been \$15.06 which would have put Hamilton's proposed 2017 fee for a residential house below the average of all seven municipalities.
