Section 204 Subsection (12) stipulates, "...if a vacancy occurs for any cause,

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the Municipality may appoint a person to fill the vacancy for the unexpired portion of the term and the appointed person is not required to be a member of the improvement area."

#### HISTORICAL BACKGROUND

At its meeting held November 9, 2016, the Board of Management of the Waterdown elected Ross Nelson.

Should Council adopt the recommendation in Report PED14252(a), Mr. Nelson would replace Mr. Troy Ganci, who resigned from the Board in November 2015.
