#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

Report PED16032(a) deals with the approval of the 2017 Budget and Schedule of Payments for the Concession Street Business Improvement Area (BIA).

#### FINANCIAL - STAFFING - LEGAL IMPLICATIONS

Financial: The \$160,780 is derived from the following: \$115,499 through levying the members of the BIA, \$7,693 in deferred 2016 Shared Parking Revenue, \$8000 in HST Refunds, \$9,588 in funds carried over from the 2016 Concession Streetfest and Sidewalk Sounds events and \$20,000 from existing funds in the BIA's bank account. There is no cost to the City of Hamilton for any part of the Operating Budget.

Staffing: There are no staffing implications.

Legal: The Municipal Act, 2001, Section 205, Sub-section (2) dictates that City

Council must approve Budgets of BIAs.

#### HISTORICAL BACKGROUND

At its Annual General Meeting held on November 22, 2016, the Concession Street BIA Board of Management presented its Proposed Budget for 2016. The process followed to adopt the Concession Street BIA's Budget was in accordance with the BIA's Procedure By-law.
