FACT

WATER IS GOING TO BE AN INCREASING ISSUE WITH CLIMATE CHANGE AND CHANGING PRECIPITATION PATTERNS

IMPLICATIONS: NESTLE GROUNDWATER EXTRACTION

F NESTLE GETS THE NEXT PERMIT FULFILLED IN ELORA, THEY
WOULD BE TAKING OVER SIX MILLION LITRES OF WATER A
DAY FROM THE GRAND RIVER WATERSHED
THIS IS A WATERSHED WHERE THERE ARE 11,000 FIRST
NATIONS PEOPLE WITHOUT RUNNING WATER



CHARGES NEED TO INCREASE TO DETER EXTRACTION

OTTLED WATER COMPANIES IN ONTARIO MAY SOON HAVE TO AY MORE AND TAKE LESS WATER **AS PUBLIC OUTCRY** OVER EVELATIONS THAT THE PROVINCE CHARGES THEM JUST \$3.71 FOR VERY MILLION LITRES TRIGGERED A GOVERNMENT REVIEW.

WYNNE CONCEDED IN FEBRUARY THAT THERE IS A DIFFERENCE ETWEEN TAKING WATER FOR AGRICULTURAL OR INDUSTRIAL USE AN AKING IT TO SELL BOTTLED WATER, AND AGREES THAT SOME OF THE CONDITIONS OF THE PERMITS FOR BOTTLED WATER USE ARE DUTDATED.



- THE ENVIRONMENTAL REGISTRY NOTICE PROPOSES A NEW WATER CHARGE, TO BE APPLIED TO GROUNDWATER SOURCED WATER BOTTLING PERMIT HOLDERS ONLY, OF \$500 PER MILLION LITRES. THIS CHARGE IS INTENDED TO PARTIALLY RECOVER THE COSTS OF THE PROVINCE'S EFFORTS TO "GAIN A BETTER UNDERSTANDING OF AND TO MORE EFFECTIVELY MANAGE
- GROUNDWATER TAKINGS BY WATER BOTTLING FACILITIES WILL INCLUDE "ENHANCED MONITORING AND DATA MANAGEMENT TOOLS, EDUCATIONAL AND GUIDANCE MATERIALS, STAFFING, SUPPORTING ENGAGEMENT WITH STAKEHOLDERS"
- MANAGEMENT PROGRAMS.



BOTTLES ARE A PROBLEM

ALTHOUGH MANY COMPANIES HAVE TRIED TO CUT DOWN ON THE AMOUNT OF PLASTIC THEY USE AND INCREASE THE PROPORTION OF RECYCLED AND COMPOSTABLE MATERIALS, THE INDUSTRY STILL SENERATES SIGNIFICANT WASTE AND CONSUMES WATER AND FOSSULES IN THE PROCESS OF BOTTLING AND TRANSPORTING ITS PRODUCTS





ENERGY CONSIDERATIONS

THE PACIFIC INSTITUTE CONDUCTS RESEARCH ON WATER USE AND CONSERVATION

HEY ESTIMATED THAT BOTTLED WATER IS UP TO 2,000 TIMES NORE ENERGY-INTENSIVE THAN TAP WATER.

OTTLES USED TO PACKAGE WATER TAKE OVER 1,000 YEARS OF BIO-DEGRADE AND IF INCINERATED, THEY PRODUCE TOXICUMES. IT IS ESTIMATED THAT OVER 80% OF ALL SINGLE-USE WATER BOTTLES USED IN THE U.S. SIMPLY BECOME "LITTER."

IT IS ESTIMATED THAT ACTUALLY 3 LITRES OF WATER IS USED TO PACKAGE 1 LITRE OF BOTTLED WATER. SOURCE:




PROBLEM WITH PLASTICS

LASTIC BEVERAGE BOTTLES ARE MADE FROM PET POLYETHYLENE TEREPHTHALATE) POLYMER.

CCORDING TO THE EPA, TOXIC POLLUTANTS, INCLUDING TYRENE, BUTADIENE AND METHANOL ARE RELEASED INTO THAT DURING ITS PRODUCTION.

COMPOUNDS LEACH INTO REUSED WATER BOTTLES AS WELL



o produce a bottle of water, it takes two bottles full of water and ¼ a bottle full of oil.

PRECEDENTS

TORONTO HAS BANNED THE SALE OF BOTTLED WATER AT ALMUNICIPAL FACILITIES AND PARKS

OTHER CITY ADMINISTRATIONS AND GOVERNMENT
DEPARTMENTS HAVE ALSO MOVED TO LIMIT PUBLIC SPENDING
ON BOTTLED WATER, INCLUDING VANCOUVER AND
ENVIRONMENT CANADA, WHICH SAID IT HAS REDUCED ITS
PURCHASES OF BOTTLED WATER BY 90 PER CENT SINCE
2007/08.



THERE IS NO COMPARISON WITH THE ENVIRONMENTAL FOOTPRINT OF SOTTLED WATER. SOME ARGUE THAT THE PLASTIC FOOTPRINT IS THE SAME AS IT IS WITH OTHER DRINKS WHICH COME IN BOTTLES. TRUE.

WATER THE ALTERNATIVE ISN'T SODA, IT'S TAP WATER.

AND THE ENVIRONMENTAL FOOTPRINT OF BOTTLED WATER VASTLY EXCEEDS THE ENVIRONMENTAL FOOTPRINT OF CHEAP, HIGH-QUALITY TAP WATER.
