Re Bay Street Stop LRT

I am dismayed by a recent decision by the General Issues Committee, which voted to reverse the unanimous LRT Sub-Committee vote, to cancel the Bay Street LRT stop. There is no sound reason why Council should insist on less LRT access in the downtown core. If there is any concern it might be for greater access to downtown locations and transfer points.

I am writing to request that City Council reverse the GIC decision, and instead uphold the unanimous LRT Sub-Committee vote, to approve the request for a Bay Street stop. I cannot understand any other rational decision.

The LRT Sub-Committee's recommendation is based in part on Provincial funding. The City of Hamilton has nothing to lose, unless it insists on following the lead of the General Issues Committee vote.
