

- Residents need & demand good rapid transit










# Good rapid transit systems should <u>not</u> be continually watered down.

### This tactic is called "BRT creep"





#### **OTTAWA ROBUST BUS SYSTEM**

- All bus stops display route numbers Even all unsheltered stops. <u>GUARANTEED</u>
- All bus stops display lookup info
  ...phone/text/online info on 'flag'...
  Even all unsheltered stops. <u>GUARANTEED.</u>
- Most shelters have a map Includes Transitway BRT routes & soon LRT
- Attracts new transit users




#### **HAMILTON UNDERFUNDED BUSES**

- Many bus stops have no route info <u>NO</u> route numbers, <u>NO</u> maps
- Many bus stops have no contact info <u>NO phone info, NO text info, NO web info</u>
- Most HSR shelters are missing map
- Does not invite new transit users






#### **Council is watering down its own 10-year Rapid Ready plan**

#### Do not start the "BRT creep" in Hamilton




## Hamilton needs a good BLAST rapid transit system beginning with A-Line <u>real</u> BRT + B-Line <u>real</u> LRT
