I am writing to request that you vote yes for the Bay Street LRT stop.

That corner is a short walk to 3 major hotels, First Ontario Centre, Sir John A Macdonald school, the David Braley medical centre,

Nation's Fresh foods and several office buildings. It is also quite a bit closer to City Hall and the Art Gallery than the James street station.

Perhaps the most important reason to put a station at Bay is all the surface parking lots on that corner which are ripe for development.

The increased tax revenue would more than pay for any additional cost to put a station there. I believe this station would be the busiest stop
