# (i) Naloxone Expansion Feasibility (BOH16036) (City Wide) (Item 5.1)

# (Merulla/Eisenberger)

- (a) That sub-section (a) to Report BOH16036, respecting Naloxone Expansion Feasibility, which reads as follows, be TABLED, as amended, for consideration during the 2017 Operating Budget process:
  - (a) That an additional 0.2 FTE (Van Outreach staff), at a total cost of \$12,261, be approved in order to increase the Public Health Services' needle syringe van by four hours per week, with the addition of a new four hour shift on Sundays (8:00 p.m. to midnight); and,
  - (b) That an additional 0.5 FTE (Public Health Nurse), at a total cost of \$56,813, be approved to provide an increase of 17.5 hours per week for a Public Health Nurse to respond client calls respecting opioid overdose and the provision of Naloxone.

- (c) That, as subsections (b) and (c) to Report BOH16036, respecting Naloxone Expansion Feasibility, which read as follows, were approved by Council on September 28, 2017 and completed, be deleted in their entirety:
  - (b) That Council send a letter to the Ontario Minister of Health and Long-Term Care with copies to the Chief Medical Officer of Health and all Ontario Boards of Health to request adequate financial resources to support the distribution of Naloxone, including distribution through provincial detention centres; and,
  - (c) That this report fulfils the request of the motion made at the Board of Health meeting on June 13, 2016 that "Public Health Services report back to the Board of Health on the feasibility of expanding the City of Hamilton's existing Take Home Naloxone Program"; and be removed from the Board of Health's outstanding business list.
