BY-LAW NO. 17-

Being a By-law to Authorize the Use of Vote Counting Equipment

WHEREAS section 42 of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996, S.O. 1996, c.32, Sch., provides that the council of a local municipality may, by by-law, authorize the use of voting and vote-counting equipment such as voting machines, voting recorders or optical scanning vote tabulators at municipal elections;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the City of Hamilton considers it desirable to pass such a by-law and has every power of a local municipality under any general or special Act;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Hamilton hereby enacts as follows:

1. The use of vote counting equipment is authorized for the purpose of recording votes at municipal elections.
2. This By-law comes into force on the date of its enactment.
