## CITY OF HAMILTON BY-LAW NO. 17-XXX To Amend By-law No. 01-216 Being a By-law to Regulate Municipal Parking Facilities

**WHEREAS** By-law No. 01-216 regulates the construction, maintenance, operation, management and regulation of municipal parking facilities, including regulations related to veteran parking;

AND WHEREAS the Veteran's Parking Program has been modified;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the City of Hamilton enacts as follows:

- 1. That Section 8. (4), General Prohibitions, be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:
- 8.(4) (a) The provisions respecting the payment of parking fees in subsections 6(2) and 11(6) and clauses 8(1)(a), 8(1)(b), 8(1)(c) and 8(1)(d) of this by-law shall not apply, at any time, to persons in respect of a parked vehicle to which a valid Ontario veteran license plate is registered.
- 8.(4) (b) No person shall park, or leave parked, at any municipal parking facility, a vehicle displaying a valid Ontario veteran license plate, for a period of time which exceeds 3 consecutive hours, unless a valid, payment receipt is displayed.
- 2. This By-law comes into force on June 1, 2017.
