## **CITY OF HAMILTON**

**BY-LAW NO. 17-  
To Amend By-law No. 01-218  
Being a By-law to Regulate On-Street Parking**

**WHEREAS**, By-law No. 01-218 regulates on-street parking, including regulations related to veteran parking; and

**WHEREAS**, the Veteran's Parking Program has been modified;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the City of Hamilton enacts as follows:

1. That Section 8. (9), On-Street Parking Meter Regulations, be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:
  8. (9) (a) The provisions respecting the payment of parking fees in clauses 8(5)(b) and 8(5)(c) of this by-law shall not apply, at any time, to persons in respect of a parked vehicle to which a valid Ontario veteran license plate is registered and affixed.
  8. (9) (b) No person shall park, or leave parked, at any metered parking space, a vehicle displaying a valid Ontario veteran license plate, for a period of time which exceeds 3 consecutive hours, whether or not there is shown on the meter time which is paid for and unexpired.
1. This By-law comes into force on June 1, 2017.
