6.1 World Citizenship Awards

- 1) To open nominations for the 2017 World Citizenship Award from February 20, 2017 to April 30, 2017, with the final award presentation to be held in May 2017 with a date to be determined;
- 2) To form a 2017 World Citizenship Award Working Group, authorized to update materials with edits for dates, contact information, including other relevant information and to bring back a draft work plan including a budget for the event, to the Hamilton Mundialization Committee's February 15, 2017 meeting;
- 3) To authorize the 2017 World Citizenship Award Working Group to approach Council members and/or community members to inquire about interest to act as a judge for the awards, during the first week of May 2017;
- 4) To request that City staff update the Mundialization Committee webpage on the City of Hamilton website to reflect the 2017 World Citizenship Award information, including application forms when available and;

5) That the Mundialization Committee authorizes the Chair to write a community column promoting the World Citizenship Award for Hamilton Mountain News and/or Letters to the Editor of The Spectator.
