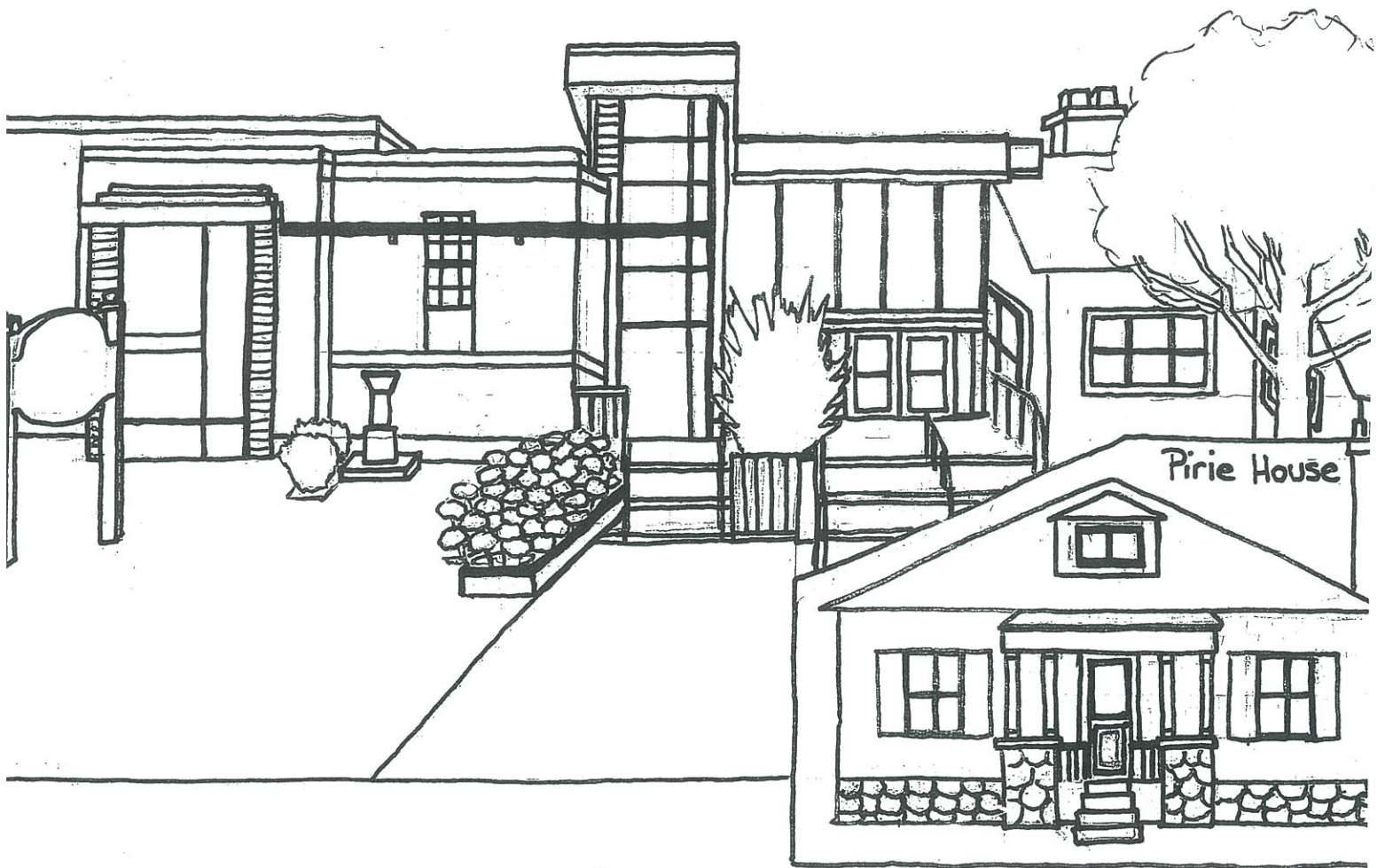

# DUNDAS MUSEUM AND ARCHIVES

139 Park St. W.  
Dundas, Ont.



The original 1956 structure was renovated in 2012-2013 to integrate the museum and the 1873 Pirie house into an accessible multi-purpose facility

# EMPIRE TIMES BUILDING

41 King William St.  
Hamilton, Ont.



Built in 1890 and with renovations completed in 2014 the Empire Times is a significant revitalization project in Hamilton's Downtown Core.

# HAMBLY HOUSE

170 Longwood Road N.  
Hamilton, Ont.



Constructed in 1939 this house is a rare example of Art Moderne residential design in Ontario and is even more rare in Hamilton.

# MOHAWK TRAIL SCHOOL MUSEUM

20 Education Court  
Hamilton, Ont.



Originally located on Mohawk Rd. W. it was used as a classroom until 1966. This prime example of a 19th century 1-room schoolhouse was moved to the new H.W.D.S.B. headquarters in 2014.

# ORR HOUSE

604 Hwy #8  
Stoney Creek, Ont.



Built in 1907 as a single-family home for W.M. Orr, its heritage features were well respected during renovations. Orr house has been a dental office since 2005
