

## Fight for \$15 and Fairness Hamilton

The Ontario Liberal Government has heard our demands and is proposing changes to workplace rules. Changes would include a \$15 minimum wage, 2 paid emergency days, fairer rules around scheduling, equal pay for part time and full time workers, and easier unionization for temp workers, building service workers, and home-care workers.

These are amazing gains, and we need to get this legislation passed! But many of the #Fightfor15 demands are still missing, including:

- Minimum 7 paid sick days for all workers
- An end to all exemptions (for agricultural workers, domestic workers)
- . Ending the sub-minimum wage for servers and students
- An end to 'just-in-time' scheduling
- Ensuring the right to organize and strengthening unions for ALL workers
- Meaningful steps to ensure proper enforcement

There is still time to ensure we get meaningful change - we need your help showing that Hamilton supports decent work.

I call on Hamilton City Council to support the Fight for \$15 and Fairness and to urge the Province to include these demands in their upcoming legislation.
