Project Goals

- Minimize movement of bed bugs
- Identify and reduce significant infestations
- Create living, work and community spaces that are less receptive to bed bug infestations



Direct Assistance

- 48 residents received assistance with bed bug preparation
- 66 residents received consultation / mediation assistance
- 90% of those directly assisted report significant improvement

Education & Prevention

- 13 Bed Bug Fact Sheets
- 6 self help videos online
- Print and electronic media advertising
- 14,000 webpage visits/year
- 8000 bulk waste bags distributed this year

Workplace Training & Policy

- Resource kit developed including workplace precaution videos
- 5 workplace consultations and policy workshops completed
- 60 organizations scheduled for workshop

IPM Training

- 300+ property mgt. staff trained in IPM
- Developed No Shame / No Blame policy
- Tenant education project underway with 10,000 apartment units targeted.
- Evaluation of IPM approach including tenant education is underway


