The pain of loss for my son Aaron never coming home again and just like the other 4 families here today, we all believe that this could have all been easily avoided if they hit a barrier and <u>NOT</u>, into oncoming traffic and getting tboned. Aaron was only doing a good thing as always only him and his love of his life Kristine.

My point is that when they are crossing over to oncoming traffic this is when a death comes instead of just maybe injuries.
