Dave Anderson, Senior Facilities Officer, HWDSB, addressed the Committee regarding New School Construction, with a revised handout dated October 12, 2017. The comments included, but were not limited to, the following:

Elementary Schools

- New Greensville Elementary (Flamborough)
 - o 381 pupil places
 - Ministry funded daycare and the City funded the Community Centre and Library
 - Target opening date is September 2019
- New Beverly Central Elementary (Flamborough)
 - o 347 pupil places
 - City funded Community Centre
 - Target opening date is September 2019
- New Summit Park Elementary (Upper Stoney Creek)
 - 625 pupil places
 - Ministry funded daycare
 - Targeted construction start Spring 2018
- New Eastdale Elementary (Stoney Creek)
 - o 564 pupil places
 - Consolidation of existing Eastdale, Mountain View, Collegiate Ave. schools as identified in the 2016 Pupil Accommodation Review (PAR)
 - Target opening date is September 2019
- New Glen Campus Elementary
 - o New school construction on existing Glen Campus site
 - o 682 pupil places
 - Ministry funded daycare
 - Target opening date is 2019/2020 School Year
- New Memorial (SC) Elementary
 - o New school construction on existing Memorial site
 - o 495 pupil places
 - Ministry funded daycare
 - Target opening date is 2019/2020 School Year
- Sir Wilfrid Laurier Elementary Addition (East Hamilton)
 - New FDK addition and internal renovation to the existing school
 - 29 pupil places
 - o A result of the 2016 PAR
 - Targeted construction start is Spring 2018
 - Target opening date is September 2018

Secondary Schools

- New North Secondary School
 - South PanAm Precinct site shared with the Bernie Morelli Recreation Centre
 - 1250 pupil places
 - Targeted construction to start Spring 2017
 - Targeted opening is 2019 School Year
- New Nora Frances Henderson Secondary School
 - New site location south of Rymal Road on Upper Sherman extension
 - 1250 pupil places
 - Target construction to start Spring 2018
 - Targeted opening is 2019/2020 School Year
- Collegiate Ave.
 - New Child Care and classroom addition to the existing school
 - 213 new pupil places
 - A result of the PAR
 - Target opening date TBD
- Elementary and Secondary Facility Benchmark Projects
 - \$21 million annually to improve and expand existing facilities
