## **BY-LAW NO. 18-**

## Respecting Removal of Part Lot Control Blocks 6-12, inclusive, Registered Plan No. 62M-1240

**WHEREAS** the sub-section 50(5) of the *Planning Act*, (R.S.O. 1990, Chapter P.13, as amended, establishes part-lot control on land within registered plans of subdivision;

**AND WHEREAS** sub-section 50(7) of the *Planning Act*, provides as follows:

"(7) **Designation of lands not subject to part lot control. --** Despite subsection (5), the council of a local municipality may by by-law provide that subsection (5) does not apply to land that is within such registered plan or plans of subdivision or parts of them as are designated in the by-law."

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the City of Hamilton is desirous of enacting such a bylaw with respect to the lands hereinafter described;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the City of Hamilton enacts as follows:

1. Sub-section 5 of Section 50 of the *Planning Act*, for the purpose of creating thirtynine (39) lots for townhouse dwellings, shown as Parts 35-73, inclusive, on deposited Reference Plan 62R-20783, shall not apply to the portion of the registered plan of subdivision that is designated as follows, namely:

Blocks 6-12, inclusive, Registered Plan No. 62M-1240, in the City of Hamilton

2. This by-law shall be registered on title to the said designated land and shall come into force and effect on the date of such registration.
