COMMITTEE OF ADJUSTMENT NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING APPLICATION FOR MINOR VARIANCE

APPLICATION NO. GL/A-17:368

IN THE MATTER OF The Planning Act, R.S.O., 1990, c.P. 13, as amended and of the Zoning By-Law No. 464, of the City of Hamilton (formerly Glanbrook), Sections 4 & 12.1.3.3i).

AND IN THE MATTER OF the Premises known as Municipal number 2301 Kirk Road formerly in the Township of Glanbrook, now in the City of Hamilton and in an "A1" (Agriculture) district;

AND IN THE MATTER OF AN APPLICATION by the owners Michael & Susan Rahija, for relief from the provisions of the Zoning By-Law No. 464, under Section 45 of The Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. P. 13, so as to permit the construction of a 1 storey pole barn accessory to the existing single detached dwelling notwithstanding that a maximum gross floor area of 259.0 m² shall be provided for all buildings accessory to a single detached dwelling instead of the requirement in the By-Law which states that all buildings accessory to a single detached dwelling shall not exceed an area of 120.0 m².

NOTE:

The elevations provided do not indicate height from grade to the uppermost point of the building as defined; therefore, applicant shall ensure that maximum permitted height is not exceeded; otherwise, further variances may be required.
