REQUEST FOR SHOW CAUSE HEARING

Please be advised that pursuant to Section 12(1) of the General Provisions of the City of Hamilton Licensing By-Law 07-170, as amended, it is my intention to request that a show cause hearing be scheduled and brought before the Hamilton Licensing Tribunal to consider whether the above referenced licence should be revoked or suspended or conditions imposed.

Pursuant to Section 8 of the <u>Statutory Powers Procedure Act</u>, R.S.O.1990, c. S22 the grounds for revocation or suspension or the imposition of conditions at this hearing are:

City of Hamilton Licensing By-law 07-170, Section 12(1)(c)(vi)(3), as amended: The conduct of the applicant or licensee (in the case of partnership, the conduct of its partners, employees or agents or in the case of a corporation, the conduct of its officers, directors, employees or agents) affords reasonable grounds for belief that the applicant or licensee will not carry on or engage in the business in accordance with the law or with honesty or integrity.

## Namely,

On April 19, 2018, Mr. Harbans KALSI uttered a threat against a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer, specifically, Mr. Kalsi called Municipal Law Enforcement Officer Valandis Korakas a racist and told him that, ("one day, someone will come after you, but not me, but someone.")

The licence expires on **March 7**, **2019**. If the hearing has not been completed before the licence expires and:

- the licence holder <u>has not</u> submitted a completed application for a renewal, then
  we will request that the hearing <u>be cancelled</u>. If this is the case and the licence
  holder keeps operating without a licence, they will be doing so contrary to the
  Licensing By-law; or,
- the licence holder has submitted a completed application for a renewal, then we will request that the hearing <u>proceed</u> under Section 12(1) of the Licensing By-law as a refusal of the licence rather than as a recommendation to revoke or suspend the licence.

In accordance with the <u>Statutory Powers Procedure Act</u>, R.S.O.1990, c. S.22, we will be forwarding to the licence holder under separate cover full disclosure of all documents and testimony that will be entered into evidence on behalf of the City of Hamilton at this hearing.

We trust that this request can be accommodated as soon as practical.
