While staff recognize the importance of addressing the matters in 2.2.6.1 (i.e. provision of a range of housing types and affordabilities), it is the opinion of staff that these matters can be addressed without the requirement for a stand-alone housing strategy, and rather can be addressed through the intensification strategy, housing and homelessness action plan update, and residential zoning update.
