

HEARING NOTICE HAMILTON LICENSING TRIBUNAL

The Director of Licensing's request, made January 23, 2019, under Section 12 (1) of the City of Hamilton's Licensing By-law 07-170, for a Show Cause Hearing respecting a City of Hamilton Public Garage Multiple Use Garage Licence (Licence 15-176349 IR).

At the hearing the Tribunal will decide whether or not to uphold the refusal, and/or to revoke, suspend or have conditions imposed on your business licence. The hearing will be conducted in accordance with the *Municipal Act, 2001*, the Business Licensing By-law No. 07-170 and the *Statutory Powers Procedure Act*. The Tribunal may commence to hear a matter at any time from **10:00 a.m.** onward. Once a matter has commenced it may continue to be heard after regular business hours, until such later time as determined by the Tribunal.
