## **HEARING NOTICE** HAMILTON LICENSING TRIBUNAL

A hearing will be held before the Hamilton Licensing Tribunal on Friday, April 12, 2019 at 10:00 a.m. in Room 264 at Hamilton City Hall, 71 Main Street West, Hamilton, Ontario, to consider the following:

Deni Demirovic's appeal of the Director of Licensing's request, made February 27, 2019, to refuse an application for a City of Hamilton Building Repair Master Licence, under Section 12 (1)(a) of the City of Hamilton Licensing By- Law 07-170, as amended.

At the hearing the Tribunal will decide whether or not to uphold the refusal, and/or to revoke, suspend or have conditions imposed on your business licence. The hearing will be conducted in accordance with the Municipal Act, 2001, the Business Licensing By-law No. 07-170 and the Statutory Powers Procedure Act. The Tribunal may commence to hear a matter at any time from 10:00 a.m. onward. Once a matter has commenced it may continue to be heard after regular business hours, until such later time as determined by the Tribunal.
