²Section 17(3) of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*:

The following are prohibited from voting:

- 1. A person who is serving a sentence of imprisonment in a penal or correctional institution.
- 2. A corporation.
- 3. A person acting as executor or trustee or in any other representative capacity, except as a voting proxy in accordance with section 44.
- 4. A person who was convicted of the corrupt practice described in subsection 90 (3), if voting day in the current election is less than five years after voting day in the election in respect of which he or she was convicted.

Dear Committee,

I am writing to you in support of my application for an Election Compliance Audit in respect of John Vail's campaign for Ward 2 Councillor for the election on October 22, 2018.

I believe Mr. Vail has likely contravened subsection 88.9.1(1) of the *Municipal Elections Act* (the "Act") related to contributions by the candidate and his spouse in excess of the prescribed limit.

The prescribed limit in respect of the Ward 2 Council election was \$8,971.40.

Mr. Vail's self-reported self-financed amount was \$8,315.57 under his attached Form 4.

However, Mr. Vail reported a value of \$0 for election signs repurposed from a prior provincial election campaign, at Table 4 on page 6. I noted Mr. Vail used these signs, from his race with the Progressive Conservative Party of Ontario, in the campaign. They were cut down so as to hide the PCPO branding, but were unquestionably those same signs and they stated "VOTE JOHN VAIL".

A value of zero cannot be an appropriate valuation of those signs.

The value of goods and services donated to a campaign, for the purposes of the Act, is not their value in present condition. Value is determined by 88.15(5)(b) of the Act:

(5) The value of goods and services provided as a contribution is,

(a) if the contributor is in the business of supplying these goods and services, the lowest amount the contributor charges the general public in the same market area for similar goods and services provided at or about the same time;

(b) if the contributor is not in the business of supplying these goods and services, the lowest amount a business providing similar goods or services charges the general public for them in the same market area at or about the same time. 2016, c. 15, s. 53 (3).

I believe that a sign order from a commercial sign company for similar signs in similar volume would

be unlikely to be fulfilled for less than \$655.84, and therefore I believe that Mr. Vail exceeded his contribution limit under section 88.9.1 of the Act.

I request a compliance audit on whether Mr. Vail has exceeded the 88.9.1 limit, and to determine whether there were any other violations of the Act in relation to the donation and use of these signs.
