TERMS OF REFERENCE

Mission

The Wentworth Lodge Heritage Trust Fund Sub-committee is a decision-making body responsible for the Wentworth Lodge Heritage Trust Fund. This includes investments and expenditures.

Philosophy

The Wentworth Lodge Heritage Trust Fund Sub-committee believes that the Residents of Wentworth Lodge should derive maximum benefit from the monies donated to the Lodge.

Mandate

The Wentworth Lodge Heritage Trust Fund Sub-committee is empowered by City Council and is responsible to City Council for its activities. It reports to the Emergency and Community Services Committee of the City of Hamilton.

Goals

- 1. To manage the investment of the fund to ensure maximum returns
- 2. Where fiscally possible, to respond to needs at Wentworth Lodge, that cannot be met through the normal operating and capital budgets.
- 3. To evaluate and make decisions concerning fund raising opportunities if they are presented.

Membership

The Wentworth Lodge Heritage Trust Fund Sub-committee will be appointed by City Council and consist of:

- Ward 13 Councillor
- One Resident member
- One Alternate Resident member
- One appointee from the Family Council
- One appointee from the Dundas Senior Citizens' Club

Term of Office

The members of the Wentworth Lodge Heritage Trust Fund Sub-committee will be appointed by City Council with each new term of Council and will expire with the term of Council.

Meeting Times

Contingent on available funds, the Sub-committee will meet at least twice a year, in Spring and Fall, with additional meetings at the call of the Chair.
