## CITY OF HAMILTON

BY-LAW NO. 19-

Respecting: Removal of Part Lot Control

Lots 118-145 on Registered Plan No. 62M-1257 "Red Hill Phase 2", municipally known as 3, 4, 7, 8, 11, 12, 15, 16, 19, 20, 23, 24, 27, 28, 31, 32, 35, 36, 39, 40, 43, 44, 47, 48, 51, 52, 55, and 56 July Avenue

**WHEREAS** the sub-section 50(5) of the <u>Planning Act</u>, (R.S.O. 1990, Chapter P.13, as amended, establishes part-lot control on land within registered plans of subdivision;

**AND WHEREAS** sub-section 50(7) of the *Planning Act*, provides as follows:

"(7) **Designation of lands not subject to part lot control. --** Despite subsection (5), the council of a local municipality may by by-law provide that subsection (5) does not apply to land that is within such registered plan or plans of subdivision or parts of them as are designated in the by-law."

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the City of Hamilton is desirous of enacting such a by-law with respect to the lands hereinafter described;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the City of Hamilton enacts as follows:

DACCED this 12th day of November 2010

1. Sub-section 5 of Section 50 of the <u>Planning Act</u>, for the purpose of creating twenty-eight (28) easements for access and maintenance purposes, shown as Parts 1 to 28, inclusive, on deposited Reference Plan 62R-21274, shall not apply to the portion of the registered plan of subdivision that is designated as follows, namely:

Lots 118 to 145 on Registered Plan No. 62M-1257, in the City of Hamilton.

- 2. This by-law shall be registered on title to the said designated land and shall come into force and effect on the date of such registration.
- 3. This by-law shall expire and cease to be of any force or effect on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of November 2021.
