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First 6 Months Report

July 2019:

Received the fund from Hamilton Future Fund and deposited in the bank under a separate account. This account is dedicated to the activities related to the future fund project. Two Board of Directors need to sign the cheques and all payments will be carried out as per HMS financial policy and procedure once the project consultant is certified that the work is completed in accordance of the construction staging plan/tender document and progress payment can be processed.

Communication and recognition of Hamilton Future Fund:

Immediately after receiving the fund we sent an official email communication to all our members and stakeholders. The community is very well pleased with the grant and is grateful to Hamilton Future Fund and City of Hamilton. We also made detailed announcements regarding the Future Fund in the Annual General Body Meeting of Hamilton Malayalee Samajam held on 8 December 2019. The Grant announcement was also communicated through social media (Facebook).

August 2019

A consultation was held with the City of Hamilton Staff on 16 August 2019 in order to understand and learn from the design and construction process of the upcoming cricket field at the Confederation Beach Park. Steve Sevor, Manager, Sports Policy & Department Lawrence Stasiuk, Supervisor, Landscape Architectural Services, Public Works Department attended on behalf of the city. Board of Directors and members of the Property Management Committee attended on behalf of Hamilton Malayalee Samajam.

We had organized a grant ground breaking event to mark the start of the construction of the cricket ground on August 24, 2019. The event was attended by close to 500 people. We are very pleased that Hon. Councilor Terry Whitehead was the chief guest for the function. We had also invited Mayor Fred Eisenberger, Councillor Judy Partridge and other City officials also to this event.

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September 2019:

A public meeting was held on 27 September 2019 at the HMS premises to collect public feedback on the project. All the feedbacks were collected and consolidated. There were several great suggestions from cricket lovers. We will be incorporating the suggestions to develop the scope of work for this project.

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Project Activities Completed as of January 15, 2020:

- (1) We are currently preparing the Terms of reference (TOR) to appoint the Engineering consultant/landscaping architect to facilitate the Planning and Design of the Cricket field. The Draft TOR has been completed and submitted to Board of Directors for review and approvals.
- (2) Quotes were invited from various consultant to complete the Topographical survey .
