2. Accessibility Projects	\$400,000	
3. Circulation Projects	\$1,400,000	
4. Amenity Projects	\$3,100,000	
5. Garden and Planting Projects	\$1,100,000	
6. Site-Wide Improvement Projects	\$1,600,000	

 New park features will be identified for inclusion in the next DC Background Study



### RECAP

The Master Plan INCLUDES:

- Guidelines for open space planning and park management;
- Master Plan design concept;
- Action plans (park improvement projects) to guide future capital improvements;
- High level capital project cost estimates
- \* Detailed design is required for each park improvement project and may result in design modifications as deemed necessary. Consultation with other City staff will be ongoing.
