EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

In accordance with the Ministry of the Solicitor General, Missing Persons Act, 2018 Ontario Regulation 182/19, the obligation to make the annual Urgent Demand for Records report available to the public is on the Police Services Board. Each year, the Chief of Police is obligated to prepare the annual report and provide a copy to the Police Services Board, in the format approved by the Minister ie. Form 7. The Police Service Board is then responsible for making the annual report available to the public by posting it on a website in the year the report is received.
