## Waste Processing Service Operations – Central Compost Facility

- The facility passed the required annual source testing which models odour impacts to the surrounding areas.
- Staff submitted and received temporary approval to accept an additional 1000 MT at the facility in order to process all of the curbside organic waste
- Staff is currently working on determining a budget estimate to upgrade the odour management system



Waste Processing Service Operations – Material Recycling Facility

- The MRF will begin accepting merchant cardboard materials starting December 10<sup>th</sup>.
- There will be no processing fees to manage this material and it will result in a small revenue for the facility
- Commodity markets are starting to decline. There is still uncertainty about when there will be a market correction or what that will look like

## Waste Processing Service Operations – Transfer Stations/Community Recycling Facilities

- Mountain CRC Reuse store opened on Dec 1<sup>st</sup> after being closed since March 2020
- Staff are continuing to work on acquiring land for the expansion of the 4<sup>th</sup> transfer station/community recycling centre
- Holiday hours have been posted for residents



## Waste Processing Service Operations – Glanbrook Landfill

- Staff are in the final stages to release the Request for Proposal (RFP) for the design and construction of Cells C, D and E within stage 3 at Glanbrook Landfill
- Construction should begin in Q2 2022
