



To the Hamilton Cycling Committee,

I am writing this letter on behalf of Cycle Hamilton a member-supported organization that works to make Hamilton a place where people of all ages and abilities can safely get around by bike to all parts of the city. Cycle Hamilton's overarching theme for the "Cycle Year" of 2022 is to build a sense of energy, fun, and camaraderie in the Hamilton cycling community. After a hard two years of isolation and virtual meetups, we want to work to safely rebuild a sense of joy and connection that can come with biking in Hamilton.

We would like to submit a request to HCyC for financial support to cover the costs of a cycling event for Cycle Hamilton's membership and the general public. We would like to host a "[Host a Filmed by Bike Show](#)" movie night in April 2022. The "Filmed by Bike: Bike love program", is a series of light-hearted short films that showcase diverse cyclists who tell stories about bikes and their impact on their communities. With your financial support we would secure the rights to the Filmed by Bike series as well as the necessary audio/visual equipment and light refreshments.

The timing will align with the kickoff of the spring cycling season and will allow for an outdoor viewing party. This provides room for risk management with consideration to physical health and safety guidelines for COVID-19 protocols as well as ample space for people to cycle to the venue.

Approximate Cost Breakdown:

Administration/Event Planning/Implementation	\$100
Snacks and refreshments (popcorn, water)	\$100
Total	\$1575
