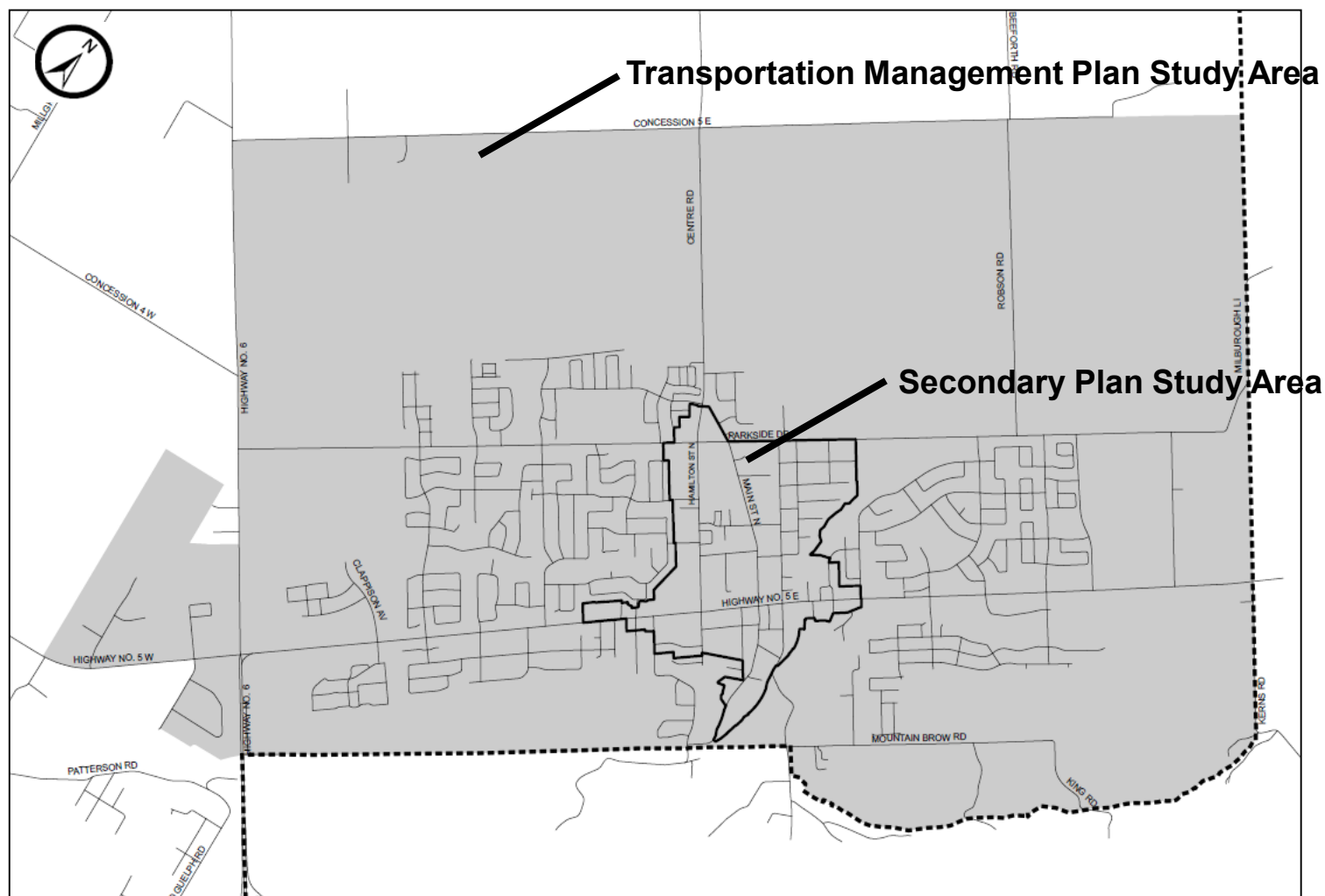

- Direction in the Urban Hamilton Official Plan for Secondary Plans to be prepared for all Community Nodes
- In 2014, Council endorsed a strategy with respect to traffic management and land use for the Waterdown Village Core area which directed that the City initiate the Waterdown Community Node Secondary Plan and initiate a Transportation Management Plan for the Waterdown Community Node (PED14047)
- Studies were initiated in late 2018 and early 2019

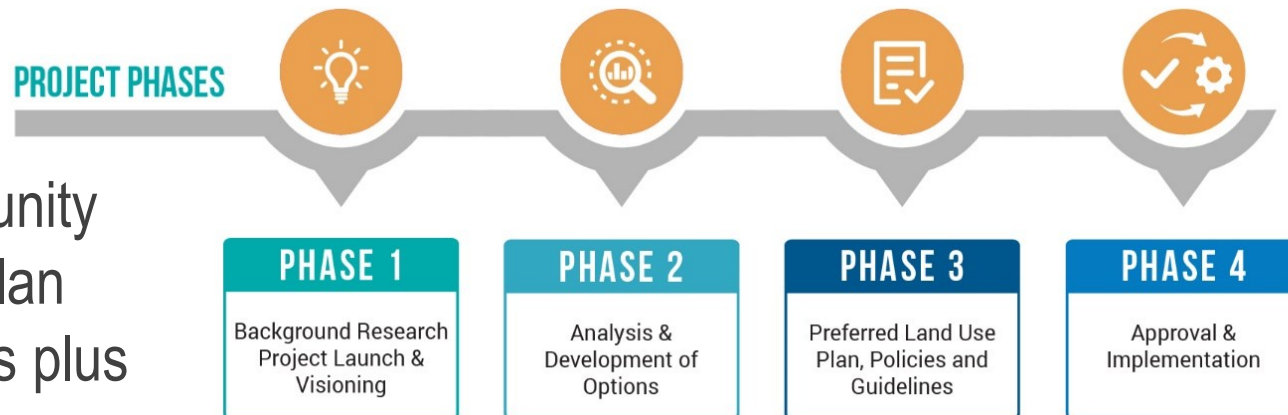


Study Processes

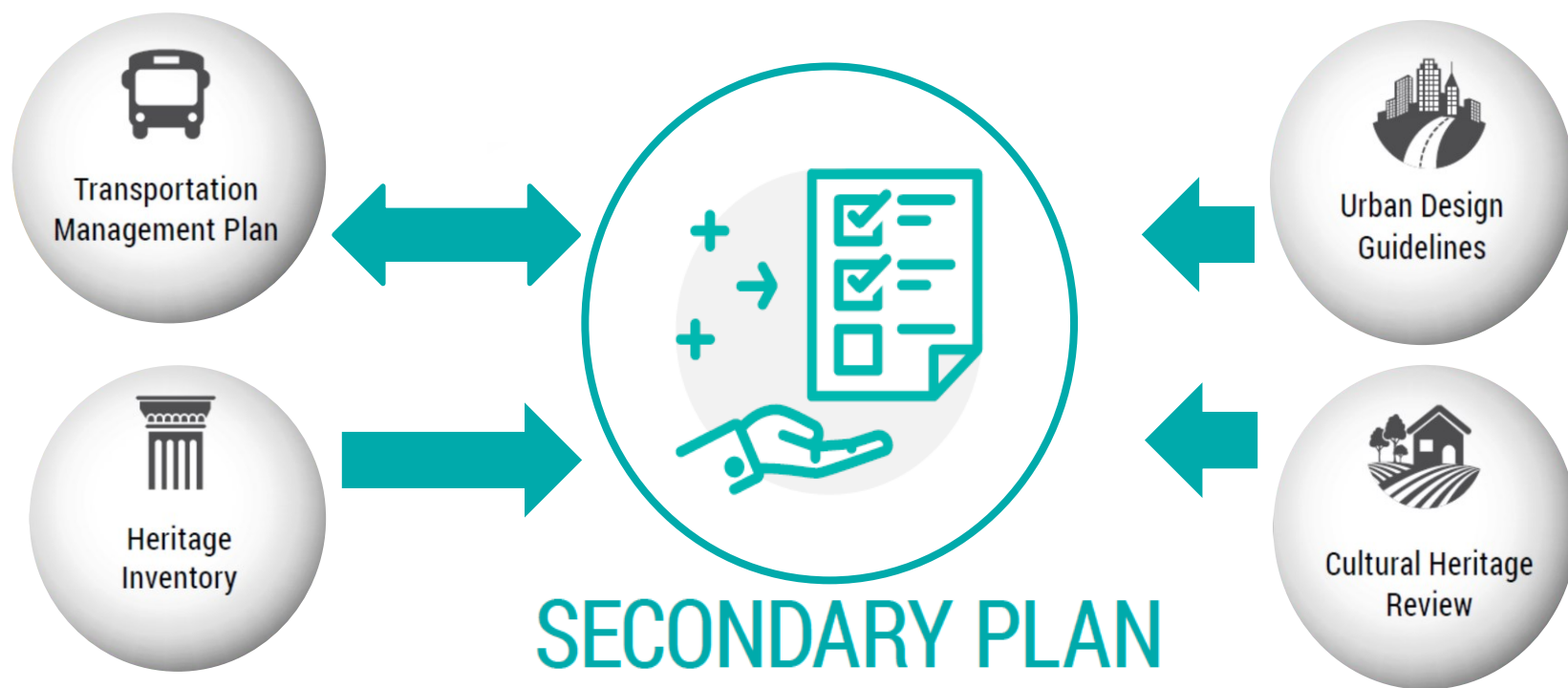
- 2 Phase Process includes Problem/Opportunity Identification and Alternative Solution Identification

- 3 Phase process plus Implementation

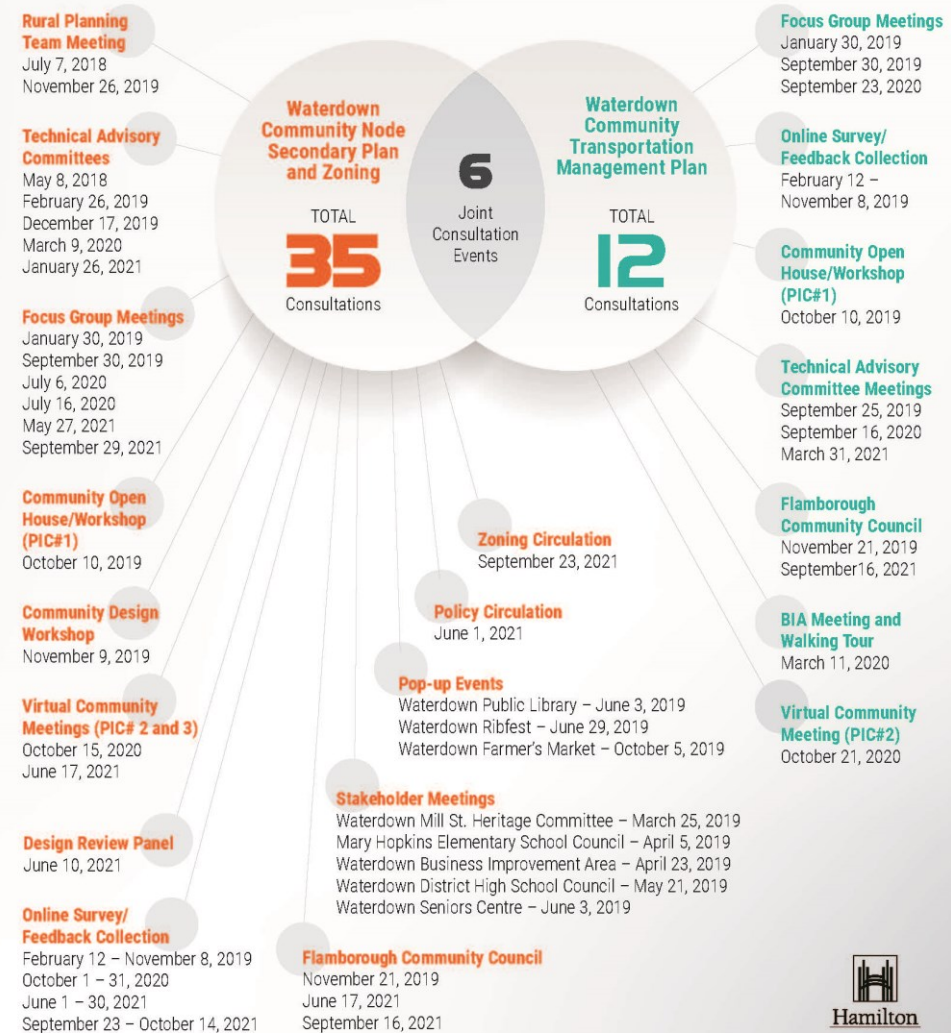
