At the same time that staff is working on this, Council authorizes 100's of thousands of dollars to be paid to consultants to run Complete Street Exercises in Wards 3, 8 and 14?

Is that work implemented in this Item 8.1?

The best part is the consultants were paid 100's of thousands of dollars out of the Special Levy Tax meant to address aging, crumbling infrastructure.

Defer this item until staff can explain whether it will even work and what it will cost.
