## Re: Hamilton Conservation Authority Board of Directors resolution related to Application to Renew Exceptions for Chair and Vice-Chair Provisions in the Conservation Authorities Act

Dear Ms. Holland,

On September 1, 2022 the Hamilton Conservation Authority Board of Directors passed the following unanimous resolution.

## BD12, 3090 MOVED BY: Brad Clark SECONDED BY: Tom Jackson

WHEREAS the governance exceptions that HCA has been granted from the Minister of the Environment, Conservation and Parks will be expiring at the end of 2022,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED

THAT the Budget & Administration Committee recommend to the Board of Directors:

THAT Hamilton Conservation Authority reapply to the Minister of the Environment, Conservation and Parks requesting an exception to the rotation of the Chair and Vice Chair position to rotate amongst participating municipalities; and further THAT an exception also be requested to the maximum two consecutive term limits for the position of Chair and Vice Chair to a maximum of four consecutive terms; and further

THAT the exceptions be based on the rationale as provided in the last exception that was approved by the Minister noting HCA's unique board composition, alignment with four-year municipal appointment terms and process of annual democratic election.
