BY-LAW NO. 22-

Respecting Removal of Part Lot Control on Block 1 Registered Plan of Subdivision 62M-1277 Central Park – Midtown, 61 Soho Street

WHEREAS the sub-section 50(5) of the *Planning Act*, (R.S.O. 1990, Chapter P.13, as amended, establishes part-lot control on land within registered plans of subdivision;

AND WHEREAS sub-section 50(7) of the *Planning Act*, provides as follows:

"(7) **Designation of lands not subject to part lot control.** -- Despite subsection (5), the council of a local municipality may by by-law provide that subsection (5) does not apply to land that is within such registered plan or plans of subdivision or parts of them as are designated in the by-law."

AND WHEREAS the Council of the City of Hamilton is desirous of enacting such a by-law with respect to the lands hereinafter described;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Hamilton enacts as follows:

- 1. Sub-section 5 of Section 50 of the *Planning Act*, for the purpose of creating 145 lots for townhouses, 76 easements for maintenance and access purposes and 1 common element road as shown on Parts 1 to 251 inclusive on Plan 62R-21946, shall not apply to the portion of the registered plan of subdivision that is designated as follows, namely:
 - Block 1, Registered Plan No. 62M-1277, and Part of Block 103, Registered Plan 62M-1250, in the City of Hamilton
- 2. This by-law shall be registered on title to the said designated land and shall come into force and effect on the date of such registration.
- 3. This by-law shall expire and cease to be of any force or effect on the 28th day of September, 2024.
