## CITY OF HAMILTON BY-LAW NO. 22-

## Respecting Removal of Part Lot Control, Block 1, Registered Plan No. 62M-1286, municipally known as 179, 183 and 187 Wilson Street West, Ancaster

**WHEREAS** the sub-section 50(5) of the *Planning Act*, (R.S.O. 1990, Chapter P.13, as amended, establishes part-lot control on land within registered plans of subdivision;

**AND WHEREAS** sub-section 50(7) of the *Planning Act*, provides as follows:

"(7) **Designation of lands not subject to part lot control.** -- Despite Subsection (5), the council of a local municipality may by by-law provide that Subsection (5) does not apply to land that is within such registered plan or plans of subdivision or parts of them as are designated in the by-law."

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the City of Hamilton is desirous of enacting such a by-law with respect to the lands hereinafter described;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the City of Hamilton enacts as follows:

 Sub-section 5 of Section 50 of the *Planning Act*, for the purpose of creating 35 Parcels of Tied Land (POTL's) for street townhouse dwellings, shown as Parts 1 to 83 inclusive, 35 access and maintenance easements (Parts 49 to 83 inclusive), 13 easements for a sidewalk (Parts 36 to 48 inclusive) and condominium common elements including a private road network, visitor parking, and amenities (Part 84) as shown on Deposited Reference Plan 62R-21920, shall not apply to the portion of the registered plan of subdivision that is designated as follows, namely:

Block 1, Registered Plan No. 62M-1286, in the City of Hamilton.

- 2. This by-law shall be registered on title to the said designated land and shall come into force and effect on the date of such registration.
- 3. This by-law shall expire and cease to be of any force or effect on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of August 2024.
