An in-person hearing will be held before the Hamilton Licensing Tribunal **on Monday, February 26, 2024, at 11:30 a.m. in Room 192, at Hamilton City Hall, 71 Main Street West, Hamilton, Ontario**, to consider the following:

Ross Williams' appeal of the Director of Licensing's request made November 23, 2023, to refuse an application for a City of Hamilton Mobile Licence – Refreshment Vehicle Class A, Pursuant to Section 12.(1)(c)(vi) of the City of Hamilton Licensing By-law 07-170

At the hearing the Tribunal will decide whether or not to uphold the refusal, and/or to revoke, suspend or have conditions imposed on your business licence. The hearing will be conducted in accordance with the *Municipal Act, 2001*, the Business Licensing By-law No. 07-170 and the *Statutory Powers Procedure Act*. If either you and/or your legal representative do not attend the hearing at the date, place and time indicated, the Hamilton Licensing Tribunal may proceed in your absence to render any decision or recommendation within its jurisdiction, and you will not be entitled to further notice of the proceeding.

The Tribunal may commence to hear a matter at any time from **11:30 a.m.** onward. Once a matter has commenced it may continue to be heard after regular business hours, until such later time as determined by the Tribunal.
