Please accept this written submission of my objection to the adoption of this by-law.

Five years ago the City of Hamilton and the developer Prologis jointly re-worked Osprey Drive, with widening of the road, sanitary sewer work, lighting, sidewalks and I would think storm sewer work.

It was my understanding Prologis was responsible for all this work. If additional work is required on the storm sewers than it should again be the responsibility of the developer who did the initial work.

We've lived here 38 years and have never experienced any issues with storm sewers so I don't understand how this will benefit my property. I also do not understand why a residential tax payer should be burden with the cost for the benefit of these developments. My taxes should be sufficient to cover costs for this property.
