## FINANCIAL IMPACT OF COMMUNITY SAFETY AND WELL-BEING



Single incident of homicide estimated to cost between \$4.8 and \$5.9 million



Sexual assaults estimated around \$136,000 to \$164,000 per incident



Robberies range from \$28,000 to \$92,000 per incident



Cost of transient homelessness \$72,444 per person

Cost of chronic homelessness is \$134,642 per person
