




Waterfront Animation and Programming 2023 Highlights



Street Mural

Over 7 days, local mural crew Clear Eyes Collective painted Hamilton's first road mural measuring over 200 feet long (5850 square feet). As select roads at Pier 8 were going to be closed to vehicles and open to pedestrians, it became a perfect test site for road murals. Additional support for this project came from the Placemaking Grant Pilot Program and the Concrete Canvas Festival.

Sonic Runway

The light-art installation Sonic Runway operated each evening from November 1-26 drawing over 20,000 people to the waterfront. In addition to Sonic Runway, temporary art installations from local artists were on display and a series of 8 special event days featured local dancers, musicians and community organizations. 
