- Graffiti Removal Standards
 - Hate graffiti – immediately (within 24 hours)
 - Non-hate graffiti – within 72 hours (dependent on contractor and staff scheduling)

Update

Hate defined as hate-speech, hate motivated, racial slur, homophobic slur, or other criminally offensive suggestions
