I'm sure you understand the benefits and how it would allow Hamilton to remain within our urban boundaries, something the majority of Hamiltonians voted in favour of. Also, I was very disappointed to hear you voted against safe injection sites. I am an ER nurse at JH and have OD patients EVERY shift I work. Lastly, I have noted that the construction on Sam Lawrence park has begun. I wanted to inform you that there is a seasonal spring located along the path going down to the right side of from Concession. There has been some gravel placed along the side but this will all be washed out in the spring. A proper creek bed should be placed to accommodate the seasonal flow. I expect this is beyond your scope but it should be passed on to parks and rec as this will incur further costs to maintain and repair.
