- (i) HP2024-037– 610 York Boulevard, Hamilton (Dundurn, Part IV), (Item 10.1)
 - Removal of six dead trees and one partially-dead, unsafe tree.

The Subcommittee considered the application and, together with input and advice from staff, passed the following motion:

- (a) That the Heritage Permit Review Subcommittee advises that Heritage Permit Application HP2024-037 be consented to, subject to the following Conditions:
 - That the details for removal of the stumps be submitted, to the satisfaction and approval of the Director of Planning and Chief Planner, prior to commencement of the stump removals;
 - (ii) That any minor changes to the plans and elevations following approval shall be submitted, to the satisfaction and approval of the Director of Planning and Chief Planner, prior to submission as part of any application for a Building Permit and / or the commencement of any alterations; and
 - (iii) That implementation / installation of the alteration(s), in accordance with this approval, shall be completed no later than November 30, 2026. If the alteration(s) are not completed by November 30, 2026, then this approval expires as of that date and no alterations shall be undertaken without a new approval issued by the City of Hamilton.

(ii) HP2024-036 - 122 MacNab Street South, Hamilton (MacNab-Charles HCD, Part V), (Item 10.2)

 - Painting the new wood steps to match the previous colour; and,
 - Selective masonry repointing.

 - (iii) That any minor changes to the plans and elevations following approval shall be submitted, to the satisfaction and approval of the Director of Planning and Chief Planner, prior to implementation of the alterations.

• Demolition of the former Tivoli auditorium and lobby structures.
