

- (a) the retirement home shall be sprinklered,
- (b) a voice communication system conforming to Article 3.2.4.23. shall be provided in the building, if Clause 3.2.6.8.(1)(b) or (c), as applicable, requires that such a voice communication system be provided in the building, and
- (c) doors to suites and sleeping rooms not within suites in the retirement home, other than doors leading directly to the exterior, shall be equipped with selfclosing devices.

11.3.4. Plumbing

11.3.4.1. Extension, Material Alteration or Repair

- (1) Despite Subsections 11.3.1. to 11.3.3., when an existing building is extended or subject to material alteration or repair, Part 7 applies,
 - (a) to the design and construction of plumbing in the extensions and those parts of the building subject to material alteration and repair, and
 - (b) to plumbing which is adversely affected by the extension, alteration or repair.

11.3.5. Sewage Systems

11.3.5.1. Existing Septic Tanks

(1) Despite Subsections 11.3.1. to 11.3.3., where an existing septic tank is subject to material alteration, repair or replacement, the construction of the septic tank shall comply with Part 8.

11.3.5.2. Vertical Separations and Existing Sewage Systems

(1) Despite Subsections 11.3.1. to 11.3.3., where an existing sewage system is extended or is subject to material alteration or repair, the requirements respecting the vertical separation to the water table set out in Part 8 apply to the extended, altered or repaired portions of the sewage system as well as to the existing portions of the sewage system.

Re: Freedom of Information Reque

I write in response to your request to access records pursuant to the provisions of the *Municipal Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* (the *Act*) and your attendance at our office on December 10, 2024, and our recent email exchange; this is the City of Hamilton's access decision.

The details of your request are stated below and were directed to the City's Corporate Services department for record searches and a response to our office.

Call recording occurring on or around May 2, 2024 at approximately 12:02 lasting approximately 19m 34s. And all conversations thereafter.

I also note that at our impromptu December meeting you agreed to my suggestion that a request for all details pertaining to your property address and the matter of the installation of a back flow valve at the address, be circulated to the City's Public Works department; this has been done and our office awaits the results of the department's record searches.

In the meantime, staff from the Corporate Services department's Customer Contact Service division completed searches and identified seven (7) records as responsive to the request details. The records are transcripts for May 2, 2024; May 17, 2024; May 17, 2024; May 30, 2024 (2); June 5, 2024; and June 14, 2024.

I have reviewed the records in accordance with the provisions of the Act, and I am pleased to advise that no exemptions attach to the records to preclude full disclosure of the records to you.

No processing fees attach to your request and a copy of the records is attached.

Pursuant to section 39 (1) of the *Act* you may request a review of this access decision within 30 days of the date of the decision by sending a completed *Appeal Form* (available at www.ipc.on.ca) or letter to the IPC Registrar, Information and Privacy Commissioner/Ontario, 2 Bloor Street East, Suite 1400, TORONTO ON M4W 1A8, telephone: 1-800-387-0073.

The appeal is to include:

- 1. your legal name, address, email address and telephone number;
- 2. the Institution's name (City of Hamilton);
- 3. the freedom of information request file number assigned by the City;
- 4. a copy of the City's decision letter;
- 5. a copy of the request;
- 6. a brief explanation of the basis for the Appeal;
 - an acknowledgment and agreement by the Appellant that the Appeal will be processed in accordance with the IPC Code of Procedure for Appeals, and,
 - 8. the Appeal fee of \$25.00 payable to the Minister of Finance

Further, please note that a separate access decision will be issued to you after our office receives the results of the record searches completed by the staff of the Public Works division.
