The following variances are requested:

1. The maximum combined lot coverage of all building's accessory to the Single Detached Dwelling shall not exceed 63 square metres or 8.8% of the lot area, instead of the requirement that the maximum combined lot coverage of all accessory buildings shall not exceed 45 square metres or 7.5% of the lot area whichever is the lesser.

PURPOSE & EFFECT: To permit the construction of an accessory building within the rear yard of an existing Single Detached Dwelling.

Notes:

i. Please note that no elevation drawings have been provided by the applicant to confirm the height of the proposed accessory building. The Zoning By-law permits a maximum height of 4.5m for an accessory building/structure. Based on the application, a maximum height of 3.04m is proposed. Additional variances may be required if compliance with Section 4.8(g) cannot be achieved.

This Notice must be posted by the owner of any land which contains seven or more residential units so that it is visible to all residents.


