#### The new SWMMP aims to:

- Reduce environmental impacts from waste management activities
- Enhance resource conservation opportunities within the City
- Improve the overall performance of the City of Hamilton's waste management system

## Existing SWMMP guiding principles:

- Manage residual waste within Hamilton's boundaries
- Optimize landfill space
- Encourage waste minimization



## **Development Phases:**

- Phase 1: Investigation
- Phase 2: Ideation
- Phase 3: Finalization
- All phases include public engagement





## Phase 1 (Investigation):

- Identify key challenges and opportunities
- Shape future planning and decision-making
- Develop draft options for improvements
- Gather input from the public on new vision and principles
- Gain insights on current programs and services

- **Current State Analysis**
- Data Management & Key Performance Indicators review

- Launch updated City webpage
- Launch Engage Hamilton webpage
- Public open house #1
- WMSC engagement sessions



## Phase 2 (Ideation):

- Evaluate different options
- Develop framework to assess options
- Identify effective approaches
- Review and receive feedback on findings from Phase 1 engagement
- Share updated guiding principles and vision
- Seek input on proposed options
