Information

Please be advised that Hamilton City Council approved the recommendations laid out in Report PED25070 during a Hamilton City Council session on March 4, 2026. As such, please be advised that on March 25, 2026, the City of Hamilton served notice to the property owner and to the Ontario Heritage Trust indicating that the City of Hamilton intends to designate 200 Main Street East, Hamilton (First-Pilgrim United Church) under Section 29 of the *Ontario Heritage Act*, as being property of cultural heritage value.
