Hello Clerk and Councilors,

I would like to have my comments submitted to the amendment application at 471
moxley rd

1. Yet again we are proposing taking agricultural lands and turning them into industrial. We are in a food security situation, we cannot rely on USA for food anymore. We need to keep every inch of viable farmland we have.
2. Water tables: the surrounding area has been suffering a drought for over 8 months now with no let up in sight. Our wells are completely dry!!!! Next door is a gravel pit that continues to alter the ground water table even further. Putting on non pervious concrete, steel and glass will mean this naturally falling water will wash away quickly down the escarpment and NOT be able to recharge local aquifers.
3. Climate emergency: adding more heat absorbing areas like these are the worst possible scenario when we have a climate change emergency. This will only retain more heat and push up local temps.
4. Stop Sprawl: the entire council voted against sprawl in Hamilton and its time to reject these zoning amendments
